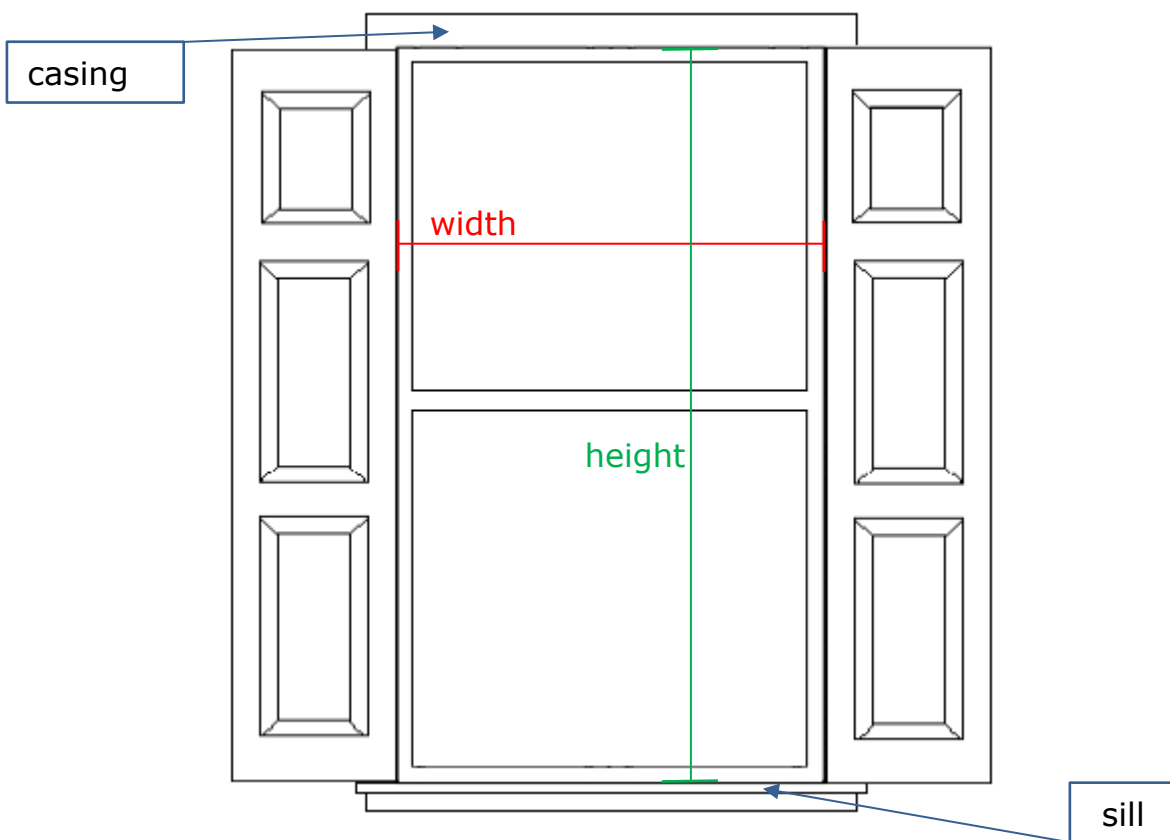


Measuring for Exterior Shutter Pairs

To figure out the sizing information for exterior shutter pairs, measure the opening inside your window casing. You can measure in two or three locations to ensure it is accurate. This is the area most shutters typically fill when closed to protect your window and they look best when sized correctly, even if they will only be displayed open for decorative purposes. Order all shutters on the actual height needed. To achieve the most authentic appearance for your shutters, mount them to the face of the window casing with functional hinges and holdbacks. Both louvered panels and raised (or flat) panels are measured using the same method.
